### What is ADEC?

### What is the Flexible Service Response?



This service is under The **Home and Community Care Program for Younger People (HACC-PYP)**. Aimed at assisting people under the age of 65 and their unpaid carers and family members.

This service offers information for people to:

- Learn **WHAT** government services are available
- Understand **HOW** services may help
- Get support to **APPLY** for services that will help

### Who is Eligible?

People who are:

- Aged under 65 years
- Not eligible for National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS)
- Those with diagnosed and undiagnosed mental health issues
- Those who are socially isolated
- Those adversely affected during Covid lockdowns
- Carers or family members of people that satisfy the above criteria
